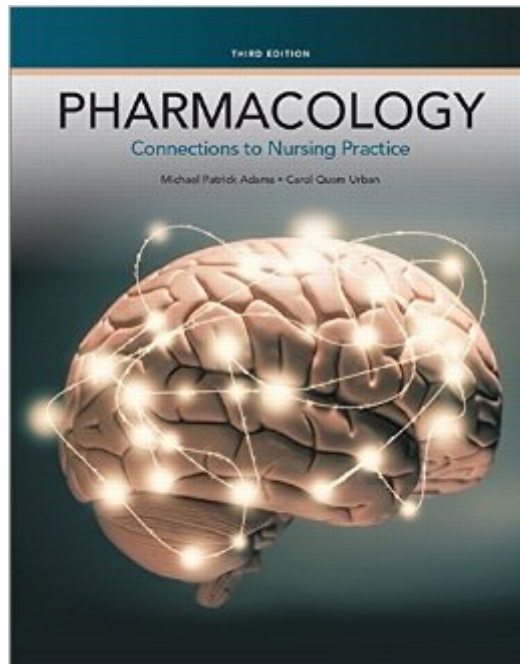


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Pharmacology: Connections To Nursing Practice (3rd Edition)
