

This is known as the "near voice" since you are creating the voice of a character who is typically right next to you. This book will teach you all you need to know to begin doing shows of your own. "Throwing your voice" also known as the "distant voice" is a very different technique, and is not covered. It is very advanced and rarely found in print, as it involves hearing the ventriloquist demonstrate the technique.
