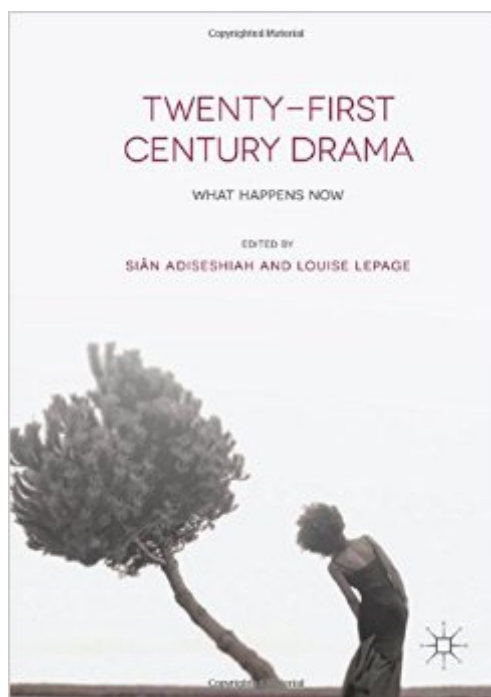


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Twenty-First Century Drama: What Happens Now

The volume's central themes the financial crisis, austerity, climate change, new forms of human being, migration, class, race and gender, cultural politics and issues of nationhood are mediated through fresh, cutting-edge perspectives.

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
